## AUTOMATIC DISH WASHING MACHINE



Rinse Aid should be used with a correctly installed dispenser. Fitted into an automatic dish washing machine. Refer to your user manual for correct dispensing units.

### **HEALTH & SAFETY**

- Refer to Safety Data Sheet (SDS) before use.
- Avoid contact with skin & eyes.
- If chemical comes into contact with eyes, rinse with sterilised water or saline for at least 15 minutes, and seek medical attention.
- If chemical comes into contact with skin, wash affected area quickly and thoroughly, and seek medical attention.
- Avoid breathing mist & vapours.
- Wash hands after use.
- Wear protective clothing, gloves & chemical goggles.
- Do not mix with other chemicals, only mix with water.
- If poisoning occurs, do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention.
- Keep out of reach from children.

# STORAGE

- Store in a dry place, tightly sealed.
- Protect from sunlight and away from other materials.
- KEEP AWAY FROM ACIDS AND. CORROSIVE SUBSTANCES.

### SPILL INSTRUCTIONS:

Slippery when spilt. To avoid accidents, clean up immediately. Wear protective goggles, gloves and face mask to prevent skin and eye contact. Avoid breathing in the fumes. Remove all sources of ignition. Take precautionary measures against static discharge. Ensure electrical continuity by bonding and earthing all equipment. Contain - prevent run off from entering drains and waterways. Store in a bunded area. Collect spill using absorbent material then seal in properly labelled containers or drums for disposal. Clean the spill area by washing with large quantities of water. Spill area will be slippery until completely dry.
